Following are details of the RRBMC Memorial Day Meet and Tour. Enclosed are a registration form and information necessary to make hotel reservations. Tour participants need to complete the registration form and return it with a check to cover all fees. Hotel reservations must be made directly by the tour participants. Bear in mind that there is a cut-off date of May 1 for making hotel reservations. Room blocks will be released after that date.

Sunday, May 24:

Meet at Day's Hotel, Flatwoods, West Virginia. Flatwoods is at the geographic center of West Virginia on I-77 at Exit 67, 90 miles south of Morgantown and 69 miles north of Charleston. Trailers may be parked at the hotel for the week of the tour. Cocktails with a cash bar will be served at 5:00 p.m. and a welcome dinner at 6:00 p.m.

Monday, May 25

From Flatwoods the tour will go by back roads, including a lunch stop, to Snow Shoe, West Virginia for an overnight stay. Snow Shoe is a well developed ski resort where we will have excellent accommodations in the Allegheny Springs Condo complex located in Snowshoe Village. Dinner will be at the elegant Embers Restaurant located a short distance from Allegheny Springs.

Tuesday, May 26

After breakfast at Snow Shoe, we drive a short distance to Cass and board a train on the Cass Railroad, an old logging railroad that climbs a steep slope up Back Allegheny Mountain to Whitaker Station to enjoy a spectacular view of the surrounding mountain scenery. Following a return to Cass, will enjoy lunch and then drive on a leisurely schedule to Charleston to stay for three nights at Embassy Suites. Dinner in Charleston this night is on your own

Wednesday, May 27

A tour of Charleston by bus will occupy the morning. A high point will be a visit to the state capitol designed by Cass Gilbert and one of the most spectacular of all the state capitols, followed by a visit to the car collection of Bill Davis. For dinner the group will move to the Clay Center, which consists of a performance center, art museum, children's museum, and planetarium. Dinner will be served in the Founders' Room at the Clay Center.

Thursday, May 28

Drive to Milton, West Virginia, for a factory tour of Blenko Glass Company, and then return to Charleston. Cocktails and dinner will be served at Edgewood Country Club overlooking the Kanawha River valley.

Friday, May 29

Today's route starts toward Huntington and then picks up the old river road paralleling the Ohio River north of Huntington. The route passes through a number of old towns reminiscent of the steamboat era. There will be an opportunity to observe one of the newer locks and dams canalizing the Ohio River. The locks routinely handle tows of barges longer than most ocean-going vessels. Further upriver, the route leaves the Ohio River and crosses a series of rolling hills to reach Flatwoods for a closing dinner at Day's Hotel.

In each case mention the name of the group to receive group rates. Note that blocked rooms will be released after May 1 and that reservations and price are no longer guaranteed.
